Another piece in the 'world's longest mural'

Nature provided a fine frame Saturday for the second section of the Land and Sea Mural at Ogden Point.

With the crisp outline of the Olympic Mountains above it and the calm water below, the official unveiling of the artistic creation celebrated an ongoing project that will eventually transform the grey lines of the breakwater into what organizers say will be the world's longest mural.

The mural will extend 762 metres on each side of the breakwater - 2,000 treatedplywood panels designed by First Nations artists and handpainted by First Nations youth.

Completion should take another three years.

The two main artists, Darlene Gait of the Esquimalt First Nation and Butch Dick of the Songhees First Nation, attended Saturday's unveiling and blessing ceremony.

Gait said the mural has provided a valuable way for youth to strive for a common cause.

"I'm just so enthused about the fact that there's young people ... who are learning to work together."

Dick said work on the mural began in 2009 with funding support from the Greater Victoria Harbour Authority, and more fundraising efforts are underway - including one being organized through the Ogden Point Enhancement Society.
